This publication is designed to be an interim descriptive booklet pending the completion of our azalea reference book.

I've tried to make this material as complete as possible regarding the basic, essential information on each azalea. Colors are described, to the best of my ability, in such a way as to be most easily visualized by the reader. Some variation in flower size, color and characteristic may occur on some azalea as the plant matures. Please be patient with them as they develop their full potential of beauty.

Of special importance in this booklet are the following notations:

- (S)-Denotes shade. Some azalea flowers have a tendency to fade or wash in full sun. The varieties so noted should be planted in high shade or semi-shade to realize the full beauty of their color.
- (F)—Denotes forcing types. These are types suitable for the florist trade. Please note the hardiness ratings to determine suitability for outdoor plantings.
 (0) Hardiness rating; The number in parentheses following the descriptions is the cold—hardiness rating in Fahrenheit degrees as best as can be determined. A number of factors may affect cold resistance and most of these azaleas have been rated according to low temperatures encountered here at the nursery. The Brookside Garden Satsuki (designated with a B number) in many cases have not been rated. However, all of these have survived winter temperatures of -10 in the Washington. D. C. area.

The descriptions in this book contain information regarding color, form, size and shape of flower, growth pattern and habit of plant, probable mature height in feet, some leaf and foliage description and blooming season. Blooming times are listed as Early, Early Midseason, and Midseason. Late Midseason and Late in order to conform to your growing area.

Approximately 300 more varieties are now being grown and evaluated here at the nursery. Many of them are new introductions and a number of them are older varieties with very sketchy information available at this time. It is my intention to have a supplement each year to provide additional information on both new and older azalea varieties. At the back of this book are some of the varieties now grown here that are being evaluated and descriptions completed.

Many thanks to a number of my customers who have provided me with information regarding the performance of various azalea varieties in other areas of the country and some other nations.
